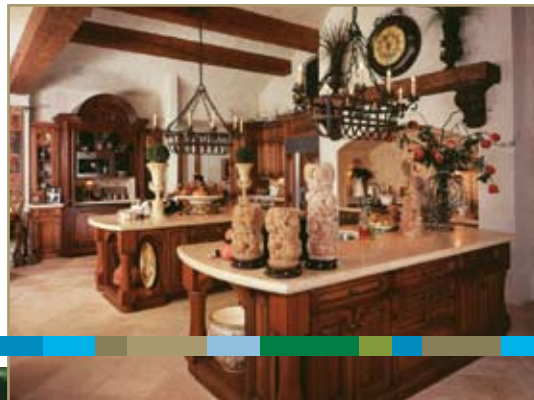

What is the **Environmental Stewardship Program?**

With the help of industry partners, the Kitchen Cabinetry Manufacturers Association (KCMA) has created the Environmental Stewardship Program (ESP) to encourage industry policies and practices that benefit the environment and society. This ground-breaking new program provides a tangible way for cabinet manufacturers and suppliers to show their commitment to environmental quality and sustainability.



What it means
To Be Certified

- Manufacturers must demonstrate compliance with stringent criteria to be awarded ESP certification. These criteria include, but are not limited to:
- 75% of particleboard, plywood and MDF used in the cabinets must be certified to meet lowest formaldehyde emission standards
 - 75% of particleboard and MDF used in the cabinets must contain 100% recycled or recovered fiber content
 - Hardwoods must be certified through an independent and credible sustainable forestry program
 - A documented energy conservation program must be in place
- A written Environmental Management System must be available and enforced
 - An active recycling program for process wastes must be in place
 - All federal, state and local environmental requirements must be observed
 - A demonstration of community involvement and leadership through service or charitable organizations
